Lab arranges collection / secure transportation to testing facility



Testing for asbestos completed in NATAaccredited lab



Lab provides Report

Report prepared in accordance with Australian Standard AS4964 outlining results of testing and advice for importation

Avoid risk of **massive fines** - Always import samples of potentially asbestos-containing materials through a current Import Permit Holder / NATA-Accredited Testing Laboratory.
